Transfer Credits

No more than three transfer courses, which may include Religion 70 and 71 (on D.F.S.P.), will be accepted for major credit. All transfer courses must be approved in advance by the Department Chair.

NON-RECORDING OPTION

No course with a grade of NR resulting from use of the Non-Recording Option may be counted for the Religion major, modified major, or minor.

How to Declare your Religion Major:

1. Request a meeting with a prospective major advisor (see Religion faculty webpage). Be prepared to discuss your academic interests, specific courses that you would like to take, and any questions you may have regarding the major. (Note: Exemptions, special permissions, and proposals need to be addressed by the Department Chair)
2. Review the requirements of the major, fill in your major worksheet with your proposed course of study, and submit the worksheet to the Religion department office. The registrar's office relies on our department office to confirm you've satisfied all the major requirements.
3. Enter your proposed course of study into your Degreeworks planner.
4. Request a meeting with the Department Chair, [Professor Randall Balmer](#), to review and approve your DegreeWorks Planner.
