However, no more than two iterations of REL 1.xx may be counted to satisfy the Minor. Approval of the Minor must be obtained from the Chair.

## **Transfer Credits**

No more than three transfer courses, which may include Religion 70 and 71 (on D.F.S.P.), will be accepted for major credit. All transfer courses must be approved in advance by the Department Chair.

## NON-RECORDING OPTION

No course with a grade of NR resulting from use of the Non-Recording Option may be counted for the Religion major, modified major, or minor.

## How to Declare your Religion Major, Minor, or Modified Major:

- 1. Request a meeting with Religion Department Chair, Professor Reiko Ohnuma. Be prepared to discuss your academic interests, specific courses that you would like to take, and any questions you may have regarding the major. Exemptions, special permissions, and proposals need to be addressed by Professor Ohnuma, as well.
- 2. Review the <u>requirements of the major</u>, <u>minor</u>, or <u>modified major</u> and fill in your worksheet (see links below) and DegreeWorks major planner with your proposed course of study.
- 3. Bring the completed worksheet to your meeting with Professor Ohnuma.
- 4. Confirm your proposed course of study for approval in DegreeWorks.
