Be prepared to discuss your academic interests, specific courses that you would like to take, and any questions you may have regarding the major. Exemptions, special permissions, and proposals need to be addressed by Professor Ohnuma, as well.
2. Review the [requirements of the major, minor, or modified major](#) and fill in your worksheet (see links below) and DegreeWorks major planner with your proposed course of study.
3. Bring the completed worksheet to your meeting with Professor Ohnuma.
4. Confirm your proposed course of study for approval in DegreeWorks.
